Occupational Therapy Observation Hour Verification

Applicants may use this form to document observation hours. Forms from other schools and/or from the site where the applicant observed are also acceptable. Upon completion, the applicant should scan and upload the completed forms to their OTCAS application.

The Presbyterian College Doctor of Occupational Therapy Program observation hour requirements are as follows:

- 40 hours of observation in at least two (2) diverse OT settings. Diverse settings are those that serve significantly different clientele: inpatient, outpatient, long-term care, schools, older adults, pediatrics, orthopedics, rehabilitation, etc.
- Observations must be with a licensed occupational therapist/occupational therapy assistant.
