## DEPARTMENTAL HONORS PROGRAM/RESEARCH Guidelines

- 1. Student requesting honors research must have a GPA of 3.20 in all courses and a 3.40 GPA in major courses.
- 2. The topic for study should be selected in consultation with the faculty advisor.
- 3. A prospectus should be prepared and submitted to the department for approval prior to registration for the term of study.
- 4. All department members must approve research proposal.
- 5. Research may be undertaken during the fall or spring semester or may be undertaken during a summer term and completed in the fall term.
- 6. Completion of the senior thesis or project should be of exceptional quality.
- Oral defense of paper/project should be made before department members and open to college community. Honors students participate in all other defenses within their discipline.
- 8. Minimum of three hours and maximum of six hours credit granted for honors research program.
- 9. The work will be appropriately designated on the student's diploma and transcript.
- 10. Upon completion of all aspects of the program, the department chair should submit appropriate form to the Registrar for recording.
- 11. Faculty advisor will receive additional compensation for the supervisor of honors research work at the end of the academic year.
